
Whereas, the Circuit Court entered into an Administrative Order 00-07 to provide for a substitute member of the County Canvassing Board for Gulf County for the September 5, 2000, election;

Whereas, there exists a run-off and a general election scheduled for Gulf County during the next two months which will precede the appointment of a County Judge to fill the role as member of the County Canvassing Board for Gulf County,

Whereas, under section 102.141(1)(a), Florida Statutes, the Chief Judge in the circuit shall appoint as a substitute member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed.

Therefore, it is ordered that The Honorable Frank McKeithen, Sheriff of Gulf County, is hereby appointed to the Gulf County Canvassing Board for the run-off and general elections for the year 2000.
