ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2005-01-03

RE: COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1, 2005

Whereas, Rule 2.050 (b) (2), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, establishes that the chief judge of a circuit "shall exercise administrative supervision over all courts within the judicial circuit;" and


Whereas, Rule 2.050 (b) (4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, allows the chief judge to assign judges to courts and divisions and determine length of each assignment and also allows the chief judge to assign any judge to temporary service for which the judge is qualified in any court in the same circuit.

Now Therefore, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the following Bay County judicial assignments will be in effect from November 1, 2005 to December 31, 2007:

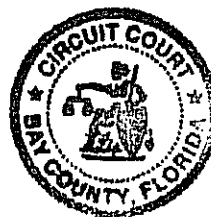
<u>Bay County Judge</u>	<u>Assignment</u>
1. The Honorable Thomas F. Welch	County Civil Division B (which represents approximately 50% of the total county civil caseload) Civil Traffic Infraction Cases which result in serious bodily injury or death (50% of the cases) Animal Control Cases (25% of the cases)
2. The Honorable John O'Brien	County Civil Division C (which represents approximately 50% of the total county civil caseload) Civil Traffic Infraction Cases which result in serious bodily injury or death (50% of the cases) Animal Control Cases (25% of the cases)

3. The Honorable Elijah Smiley County Misdemeanor & Criminal Traffic Division C (which represents 50% of the criminal caseload)
Civil Traffic Infraction cases which also involve a criminal traffic case (50% of the cases)
Animal Control Cases (25% of the cases)
4. The Honorable Michael J. Hauversburk County Misdemeanor & Criminal Traffic Division B (which represents 50% of the criminal caseload)
Civil Traffic Infraction cases which also involve a criminal traffic case (50% of the cases)
Animal Control Cases (25% of the cases)
