ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 95-08

Unless there is a contract between the county and the court reporter stating different costs, the following court reporting fee schedule shall remain in effect in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit:

CRIMINAL TRANSCRIPT RATES:


*Appeal transcript (original + 2 copies)	\$3.75 per page
Additional copies	.75 per page
*Depositions (original + 1 copy)	\$3.00 per page
Additional copies	.75 per page

In addition to the above fees, reporters are authorized to charge an extra \$2.00 per page for expedited transcripts. An expedited transcript is one where the transcript is to be completed within 72 hours or less of the time the testimony was given. If public funds are to be used to pay expedited transcripts, the presiding judge of the case must give approval before such expedited transcripts are requested. If no such prior approval has been obtained, the court may order the fee paid from the private funds of the party requesting the expedited transcript.

Payment for court reporting services provided by a Court Reporter employed by Bay County and/or Jackson County shall be made to the Board of County Commissioners for each respective county.
