ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 96-05

RE: ASSESSMENT OF COURT COSTS IN BAY COUNTY PURSUANT TO FLORIDA
RULE OF TRAFFIC COURT 6.470(A) AND SECTION 318.18(11), FLA.
STAT. (Supp. 1996)

WHEREAS Florida Rules of Traffic Court 6.470(a) provides for
the assessment of court costs and surcharges in addition to the
penalty imposed in those cases where a hearing is held to determine
whether a traffic infraction was committed; and

WHEREAS Section 318.18(11), Fla. Stat. (Supp 1996), provides
for minimum court costs to be imposed in addition to the statutory
fine; it is therefore

ORDERED:

1. In any civil traffic infraction case originating in Bay
County in which a court hearing is held to determine whether a
traffic infraction was committed a cost of \$2.00 shall be assessed
in addition to the minimum court cost and the statutory fine. This
cost shall be collected by the Bay County Clerk of Court and shall
be submitted to the Gulf Coast Criminal Justice Assessment Center
on a monthly basis.

2. This order shall become effective on October 1, 1996.
