
IN RE: FLORIDA JUDICIAL COLLEGE

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


The Florida Court Education Council developed a series of educational programs to assist in preparing every new trial judge for judicial service. This program operates under the auspices of the Florida Judicial College and includes a trial skills workshop and an orientation course (Phase One), in addition to the regular judicial college curriculum (Phase Two). The trial skills workshop and orientation course is scheduled for January 5-10, 1997, in Tallahassee.

To assure that all new trial judge have the essential information and skills to fulfill their judicial duties, each judge who has assumed the bench on or after July 1, 1996, is hereby required to participate in Phase One. All judges who have taken the bench since the Florida Judicial College, Phase Two, in March 1996 are required to participate in the 1997 Florida Judicial College, Phase Two, which will be held March 16-21, 1997, in Tallahassee. Those judges who took the bench after March 1996 but before July 1, 1996, are encouraged, but not required, to participate in Phase One of the Florida Judicial College.
