IN RE: Drug Court Participation fees for Dependency Cases

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 97-2

WHEREAS the Bay County Drug Court was created to provide immediate and concerted treatment to drug offenders (adults and juveniles) and to adults involved in dependency matters, and

WHEREAS the Drug Court participants are required to pay a participation fee of \$300.00 which will be used to help pay for treatment, and

WHEREAS ORDINANCE NO. 96-21 authorizes the Clerk of Circuit Court to collect Drug Court assessment fees for criminal offenders but does not address the collection of fees from dependency cases, therefore

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Clerk of Circuit Court collect the Drug Court assessment fees for dependency cases. The Clerk of Circuit Court is hereby directed to set forth accounting procedures that will implement the directives of this order.
