
**WHEREAS** it would aid the court in the disposition of said cases to hold court at the location where most of the offenses will occur , and

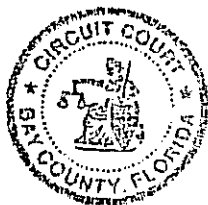
**WHEREAS** additional Judges are needed to preside over Spring Break Court, it is hereby,

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Panama City Beach City Hall shall serve as the venue for the Bay County Spring Break Court and that the Honorable Thomas R. Ellinor, retired County Court Judge, along with other Judges in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, shall be appointed to hear said cases for the duration of the Bay County Spring Break Court, 1998 term.




# Supreme Court of Florida

WHEREAS, it officially has been made known to me that it is necessary to the dispatch of business of the FOURTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT OF FLORIDA that a judge be temporarily assigned to duty in that court;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Gerald Kogan, under authority vested in me as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Florida, under article V, section 2 of the Constitution of Florida, and the rules of this Court promulgated thereunder, do hereby assign and designate HONORABLE THOMAS R. ELLINOR (Senior Judge) to proceed to the FOURTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT OF FLORIDA, and on MARCH 8 through 22, 1998, to hear, conduct, try, and determine the causes which shall be presented to the judge as a temporary judge of said court and thereafter to dispose of all matters considered by the judge on said dates, including issues of fees and costs arising out of said causes, but excluding other matters subsequently raised that are collateral to said causes. JUDGE ELLINOR, under and by virtue of the authority hereof, is hereby vested with all and singular the powers and prerogatives conferred by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida upon a judge of the court to which the judge is hereby assigned.
