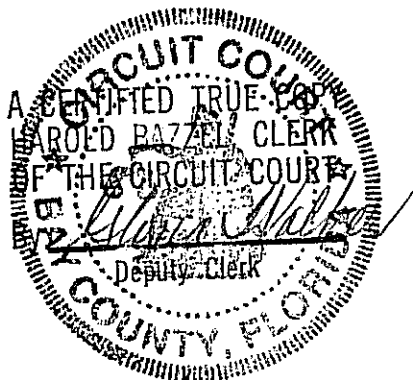
WHEREAS it would aid the court in the disposition of said cases to hold court at the location where most of the offenses will occur, and


WHEREAS additional Judges are needed to preside over Spring Break Court, it is hereby,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Panama City Beach City Hall shall serve as the venue for the Bay County Spring Break Court and that the Honorable Thomas R. Ellinor, retired County Court Judge, and the Honorable George Pierce, retired County Court Judge, along with other Judges in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, shall be appointed to hear said cases for the duration of the Bay County Spring Break Court, 1999 term.

Further, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the \$40.00 non-mandatory court costs imposed in County Court cases pursuant to Administrative Order 95-06(3) shall not be assessed on cases disposed in the Spring Break Court.
