AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 00-04

WHEREAS in Bay County of this Circuit, a Bay County Spring Break Court has been established to provide a forum for adjudication of defendants who commit offenses during the course of their spring break holidays while in the jurisdiction of this Circuit,

WHEREAS it would aid the court in the disposition of said cases to hold court at the location where most of the offenses will occur, and

WHEREAS additional Judges are needed to preside over Spring Break Court, it is hereby,

WHEREAS the original location for Spring Break Court, the Panama City Hall, was determined to be not appropriate as this year's venue, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Philip W. Griffiths Community Center at Frank Brown Park shall serve as the venue for the Bay County Spring Break Court and that the Honorable Thomas R. Ellinor, retired County Court Judge, and the Honorable George Pierce, retired County Court Judge, along with other Judges in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, shall be appointed to hear said cases for the duration of the Bay County Spring Break Court, 2000 term.

Further, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the \$40 court costs imposed in County Court cases pursuant to Administrative Order 99-05 (2) shall not be assessed on cases disposed in the Spring Break Court.
