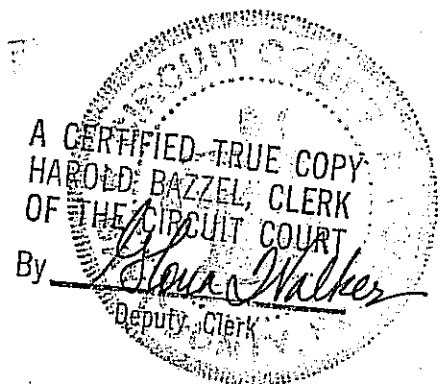
IN RE: Circuit Judge Assignments Beginning January 1, 2001  
Through December 31, 2002

WHEREAS the Chief Judge of the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit has the responsibility to ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within the circuit, and

WHEREAS the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions, and shall determine the length of each assignment,


NOW THEREFORE it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following circuit judicial assignments will be in effect from January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2002:

<u>Circuit Judge</u>	<u>Assignment</u>
I. The Honorable N. Russell Bower	One third of Bay County's civil proceedings; all of Bay County's probate, guardianship, and Baker/Marchman proceedings; and Bay County's Jimmy Ryce proceedings.
II. The Honorable Don T. Sirmons	One half of Bay County's criminal proceedings; all of Bay County's adult, juvenile, and dependency drug court proceedings; and VOP evidentiary proceedings.
III. The Honorable Dedee S. Costello	One half of Bay County's criminal proceedings and its related violation of probation arraignments and evidentiary proceedings.
IV. The Honorable Russell A. Cole	All circuit proceedings in Holmes and Washington counties; and conflict proceedings derived from Judge Wright's assignment, as needed.



- V. The Honorable Judy M. Pittman Half of Jackson County's civil proceedings; violation of probation arraignment proceedings for Judge Sirmon's Divisions; conflict proceedings derived from Judge Wright's assignment, as needed; back-up for circuit and county judges, as needed; and chief judge administrative duties.
- VI. The Honorable Glenn L. Hess One third of Bay County's civil proceedings; and all of Gulf County's circuit proceedings.
- VII. The Honorable Michael C. Overstreet One third of Bay County's civil proceedings, and all of Calhoun County's circuit proceedings.
- VIII. The Honorable William L. Wright All of Jackson County's caseload except half of Jackson County's civil proceedings.
- IX. Vacant Judgeship (to be filled January 2001) All of Bay County's juvenile proceedings, all of Bay County's injunction for protection proceedings; and all of Bay County's child support contempt proceedings.
