
In Re: County Canvassing Board for Gulf County

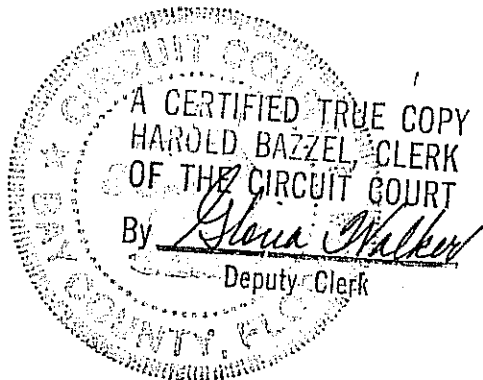
Whereas the County Judge of Gulf County, the Honorable Robert M. Moore, was killed in an automobile accident on June 29, 2000; and

Whereas, the Judicial Nominating Committee has met, interviewed and represented its candidates to the Governor of Florida but the Governor has not yet made an appointment; and

Whereas, under Section 102.141 (1) (a), Florida Statutes, the Chief Judge in the circuit shall appoint as a substitute member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with oppositions in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed.

Therefore, it is ordered and adjudged that The Honorable Frank McKeithen, Sheriff of Gulf County, is hereby appointed to the Gulf County Canvassing Board for the September 5, 2000 primary election, this 5th day of September, 2000.
