ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2004-04-03

**RE: HOLMES COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD FOR THE
NOVEMBER 2, 2004 GENERAL ELECTION**

Whereas, section 102.141 (1), Florida Statutes, provides for a county canvassing board which shall be composed of the supervisor of elections; a county court judge, who shall act as chair; and the chair of the board of county commissioners;

Whereas, section 102.141 (1)(a), Florida Statutes, states that if no county judge is able to serve or if all are disqualified, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed. In such event, the members of the county canvassing board shall meet and elect a chair;

Whereas, County Judge Robert E. Brown will be unable to serve on the Holmes County Canvassing Board due to health reasons and has requested the Chief Judge to appoint a substitute member to the Canvassing Board for the general election scheduled for November 2, 2004;

Whereas, section 102.141 (1)(b), Florida Statutes, states that if the supervisor of elections is unable to serve or is disqualified, the chair of the board of county commissioners shall appoint as a substitute member a member of the board of county commissioners who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed. The supervisor of election, however, shall act in an advisory capacity to the canvassing board.

Whereas, section 102.141 (1)(d), Florida Statutes, states that if a substitute member cannot be appointed as provided elsewhere in this subsection, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member a qualified member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy or any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed;

Whereas, the Supervisor of Election, the Chair of the Board of County commission, and the two members of the Board all have opposition in the election being canvassed;

Whereas, the remaining two members of the Board of County Commissioners are active participants in the campaign or candidacy of a candidate who has opposition in the election being canvassed;

Now Therefore, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following qualified elector, **Mr. Sidney Johnson**, who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, shall replace the Holmes County Judge, The Honorable Robert E. Brown, as a member of the Holmes County Canvassing Board for the general election scheduled for November 2, 2004. Also, that the following qualified elector, **Mr. Bill O. Gilley**, who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed shall replace the Supervisor of Elections, Ms. Debbie Wilcox Morris, as members of the Holmes County Canvassing Board for the general election scheduled for November 2, 2004.
