ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2004-06-02

RE: WASHINGTON COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD FOR AUGUST 31, 2004 AND NOVEMBER 2, 2004

Whereas, section 102.141 (1), Florida Statutes, provides for a county canvassing board which shall be composed of the supervisor of elections; a county court judge, who shall act as chair; and the chair of the board of county commissioners;

Whereas, section 102.141 (1), Florida Statutes, states that the county canvassing board shall not be a candidate who has opposition in the election being canvassed;

Whereas, a contested race exists between the current Washington County Judge and a qualified candidate for county judge for Washington County;

Whereas, under section 102.141(1)(a), Florida Statutes, the Chief Judge in the circuit shall appoint as a substitute member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed.

Therefore, it is ordered that Circuit Judge Allen Register, Circuit Judge for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, is hereby appointed to the Washington County Canvassing Board for the elections scheduled for August 31, 2004 and November 2, 2004.
