ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2006-00-08

RE: CIRCUIT JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2007

Whereas, Rule 2.050 (b) (2), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, establishes that the chief judge of a circuit "shall exercise administrative supervision over all courts within the judicial circuit;"

Whereas, Rule 2.050 (b) (4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, allows the chief judge to assign judges to courts and divisions and determine length of each assignment. It also allows the chief judge to assign any judge to temporary service for which the judge is qualified in any court in the same circuit; and

Whereas, Rule 2.050 (b) (3), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, directs the chief judge to develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within the circuit, and as part of that plan, the Chief Judge appointed a Circuit Division Assignment Committee to present a recommended division assignment.

Now Therefore, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that the following circuit judicial assignments will be in effect from January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2008:

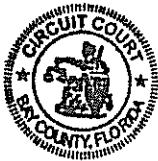
