**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2006-00-09**

**RE: ACTIVITIES ALLOWED TO BE PERFORMED BY THE  
CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT HEARING OFFICERS FOR  
THE FOURTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT (RESCINDING AO 2005-00-02)**

**Whereas**, Rule 2.050 (b) (2), Rules of Judicial Administration, establishes that the chief judge of a circuit "shall exercise administrative supervision over all courts within the judicial circuit" and further empowers the chief judge to "enter and sign administrative orders;"

**Whereas**, Rule 2.050 (e) (3), Rules of Judicial Administration, requires that all administrative orders be indexed and recorded by the clerk of the circuit court in each county where the orders are effective;

**Whereas**, a change in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer and the number of resources requires the Chief Judge to rescind the earlier Administrative Order #2005-00-02;


**Whereas**, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, on behalf of the trial courts, has entered into a cooperative agreement with the Florida Department of Revenue to fund Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officers throughout the state to handle Title IV-D cases;

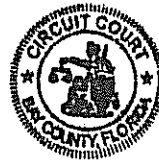
**Whereas**, as part of this cooperative agreement, each hearing officer and the receiving circuit agrees that the hearing officer will schedule, prepare for, and conduct only hearings in Title IV-D child support establishment and enforcement cases.

**Now Therefore, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that the Child Support Hearing Officers for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit shall ensure that their judicial activities related to

their positions as Hearing Officer shall be restricted to the **Title IV-D Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer Requirements** issued by the Office of the State Courts Administrator and signed by the officers upon acceptance of the positions and will limit their activities as duly outlined.
