ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2012-00-02 (RESCINDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2012-00-01)

RE: TERMINATION OF MANDATORY REFERRAL OF MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE CASES TO THE RESIDENTIAL MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE MEDIATION PROGRAM FOR CASES FILED SUBSEQUENT TO DECEMBER 20, 2011. (RESCINDING CIRCUIT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2010-00-02)

Whereas, the Supreme Court of the State of Florida has entered AOSC-11-44 which, among other things, terminated the statewide Residential Mortgage Foreclosure Mediation program and

Whereas, Administrative Order 2010-00-02 of the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida implemented the Residential Mortgage Foreclosure Mediation program in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and

Whereas, the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit finds it necessary to rescind Administrative Order 2010-00-02 in order to comply with the AOSC-11-44.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Administrative Order 2010-00-02 of the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit is hereby rescinded as of December 20, 2011.
2. All cases which were subject to Administrative Order 2010-00-02 which were filed on or before December 20, 2011 shall continue to be subject to the requirements of that order.
3. The Residential Mortgage Foreclosure Mediation Program Manager, the Collins Center, shall continue to provide mediation services for all cases filed prior to December 20, 2011 which were subject to the requirements of Administrative Order 2010-00-02.
4. This Order shall be effective immediately.
