ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2012-02-02

RE: CALHOUN COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD FOR NOVEMBER 6, 2012 GENERAL ELECTION

Whereas, section 102.141 (1), Florida Statutes, provides for a county canvassing board which shall be composed of the supervisor of elections; a county court judge, who shall act as chair; and the chair of the board of county commissioners; and

Whereas, section 102.141 (1) (a), Florida Statutes, provides that if the county judge is unable to serve or is disqualified, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed. In such event, the members of the county canvassing board shall meet and elect a chair; and

Whereas, the Calhoun County Judge, the Honorable Kevin Grover, will be unable to serve on the Canvassing Board for the General Election scheduled for November 6, 2012,

Now Therefore, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following qualified elector, Mr. Thomas Michael Tucker, is neither a candidate with opposition in the election nor is an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and shall replace the Calhoun County Judge Kevin Grover for the general election scheduled for November 6, 2012 and all associated meetings of the Canvassing Board for the November 6, 2012 General Election date.
