ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2012-03-02

RE: GULF COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD FOR NOVEMBER 6, 2012 GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, Section 102.141 (1), Florida Statutes, provides for a county canvassing board which shall be composed of the supervisor of elections, a county court judge, who shall act as chair, and the chair of the board of county commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Section 102.141 (1) (d), Florida Statutes, provides that if the chair of the county commission is unable to serve or is disqualified and consequently the board of county commissioners is unable to appoint a substitute member, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member, a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed; and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners of Gulf County requested the undersigned to appoint a substitute member of the Canvassing Board for the upcoming General Election scheduled for November 6, 2012 to replace the chairman of the Gulf County Commission,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following qualified elector, Phil McCroan, is neither a candidate with opposition in the election nor is an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and shall replace the chairman of the Gulf County Commission as a member of the Canvassing Board for the general election scheduled for November 6, 2012 and all associated meetings of the Canvassing Board for the November 6, 2012 General Election date.
