**RE: GRAND JURY SCHEDULING AND IMPANELMENT
OF THE GRAND JURY**

WHEREAS, it is the duty and responsibility of the Circuit Judges in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit to impanel and convene the Grand Jury in each of the respective counties in the circuit pursuant to Chapter 905; *Florida Statutes*.

WHEREAS, the scheduling of the Grand Jury term has been vested in the Chief Judge by s. 905.01(3), *Florida Statutes*, it is

ORDERED that

1. All Grand Juries existing in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit shall be adjourned and desist effective with the impaneling of new Grand Juries appointed in January 2014.
2. Effective January 1, 2014, all Grand Juries in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit shall be appointed for a six (6) month term.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of s. 905.01(03), *Florida Statutes*, each county within the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit shall impanel a Grand Jury each January and each July to serve for a six (6) month term.
