ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2016-00-04 (Amending Administrative Order #2015-00-06)

## RE: CIRCUIT JUDGE ASSIGNMENT PLAN BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 12, 2016, AND SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER ORDER

Whereas, Rule 2.215(b)(2), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, establishes that the chief judge of a circuit "shall exercise administrative supervision over all courts within the judicial circuit."

Whereas, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, allows the chief judge to assign judges to courts and divisions and determine length of each assignment. It also allows the chief judge to assign any judge to temporary service for which the judge is qualified in any court in the same circuit; and

Whereas, Rule 2.215(b)(3), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, directs the chief judge to develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within the circuit.

Now, Therefore, IT IS ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the following circuit court judicial assignments will be in effect from September 12, 2016 until rescinded by further order of the court.
