ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2016-02-01

RE: COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD FOR CALHOUN COUNTY-substitute appointment

Whereas, Section 102.141 (1), Florida Statutes provides that the county canvassing board shall be composed of the supervisor of elections; a county court judge, who shall act as chair; and the chair of the board of county commissioners. Alternate canvassing board members must be appointed pursuant to paragraph (e).

Whereas, Section 102.141 (1) (e), Florida Statutes provides that the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint a county court judge as an alternate member of the county canvassing board or, if each county court judge is unable to serve or is disqualified, shall appoint an alternate member who is qualified to serve as a substitute member under paragraph (a).

Whereas, it is necessary to appoint a member to the county canvassing board in Calhoun County because the county judge and the alternative member are unable to serve.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Darryl Taylor is hereby appointed to serve as a member of the Calhoun County Canvassing in place of the county judge. This appointment shall remain in effect from September 20, 2016 thru December 31, 2016 unless extended by further order of this court.
