## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2016-04-01**

## RE: CIRCUIT AND COUNTY JUDGE DESIGNATION OF AUTHORITY FOR HONORABLE LUCAS TAYLOR, Effective January 1, 2017

Whereas, Rule 2.215(b)(2), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, establishes that the chief judge of a circuit "shall exercise administrative supervision over all courts within the judicial circuit,"

Whereas, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, allows the chief judge to assign judges to courts and divisions and determine length of each assignment. It also allows the chief judge to assign any judge to temporary service for which the judge is qualified in any court in the same circuit; and

Whereas, Rule 2.215(b)(3), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, directs the chief judge to develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within the circuit.

**Now, Therefore, IT IS ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that I hereby designate and assign Honorable Lucas Taylor to perform temporary service as follows:

Matters within the jurisdiction of the county court within any county in the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit.

Honorable Lucas Taylor is further assigned to handle the following matters within the jurisdiction of the Holmes Circuit Court: Juvenile Delinquency, Probate, Guardianship, Baker Acts, Marchman Act cases, and emergency injunctions.

Said County Judges to proceed to circuit court and any county court in all counties within the circuit to hear, conduct, and dispose of all matters which shall be presented to them as a temporary judge of the circuit court or county court within the circuit.
