ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2017-00-08 A.O. 2015-00-08 is rescinded

RE: COUNTY CANVASSING BOARDS IN GULF, HOLMES, JACKSON, CALHOUN, AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES

Whereas, Section 102.141 (1), Florida Statutes provides that the county canvassing board shall be composed of the supervisor of elections; a county court judge, who shall act as chair; and the chair of the board of county commissioners. Alternate canvassing board members must be appointed pursuant to paragraph (e).

Whereas, Section 102.141 (1) (e), Florida Statutes provides that the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint a county court judge as an alternate member of the county canvassing board or, if each county court judge is unable to serve or is disqualified, shall appoint an alternate member who is qualified to serve as a substitute member under paragraph (a).

Whereas, it is necessary to appoint a county court judge and an alternate to the county canvassing boards in Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Calhoun and Washington Counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following judges are hereby appointed to serve on the designated Canvassing Boards and will act as Chair for the designated County's canvassing board in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida:
