BAY COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 2018-01-01

RE: EMERGENCY ORDER ADDRESSING JAIL OVER CROWDING

Whereas, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each circuit is charged with the authority and power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice, and

Whereas, the Chief Judge has been advised by the Bay County Sheriff Tommy Ford that the Bay County Jail Population is at an all-time high (1193) and is becoming a critical situation. (Attachment #1)

Whereas, the warden had provided a list of inmates in custody on non-violent charges that maybe candidates for pretrial release.

Whereas, public safety is of paramount concern to the court, and the court having reviewed the list, concludes that the following inmates can be released to report to their probation officer (or to the Bay County Pretrial Release Program if not on probation) no later than Monday, May 14, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following inmates are released on the current charges listed on Attachment #2 to the Bay County Pretrial Release (or probation if on reporting probation) to appear in court on their next court date to be provided by the Bay County Jail.

I hope all is well. I want to make you aware that our jail population continues to rise, and is becoming a critical situation. Our population today is 1193, which is at an all-time high. The female population is at 263, which is requiring us to hold inmates in booking pending first appearance. This represents a significant increase over our situation a year ago as shown in the email below.

As you can see from the attached, updated charts the average population is continually rising, and does not appear to be a factor of an increase in intakes as evidenced by the yearly averages. Classification is preparing a list of potential candidates for pretrial release that we will send for judicial review by tomorrow. We would appreciate your assistance, and are available to meet to discuss effective solutions as soon as possible.
