**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2022-00-01**  
*(Rescinding Administrative Order #2021-00-12)*

**RE: CIRCUIT JUDGE ASSIGNMENT PLAN**  
**JANUARY 1, 2022 – JANUARY 1, 2024**

**WHEREAS**, Rule 2.215(b)(2), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, establishes that the chief judge of a circuit “shall exercise administrative supervision over all courts within the judicial circuit.”

**WHEREAS**, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, allows the chief judge to assign judges to courts and divisions and determine length of each assignment. It also allows the chief judge to assign any judge to temporary service for which the judge is qualified in any court in the same circuit; and

**WHEREAS**, Rule 2.215(b)(3), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, directs the chief judge to develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within the circuit.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the circuit court judicial assignments are reflected on Attachment #1 as incorporated herein and shall be in effect from January 1, 2022 through January 1, 2024, unless amended or rescinded by further order of the court.
