O R D E R

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Florida has enacted Chapter 90-271, Laws of Florida, which amends filing dates for required reports in all guardianships existing in the State of Florida, and


IN ORDER to provide for the effective and efficient review of annual guardianship reports, and

IN ORDER to ensure compliance with statutory time frames for both the Clerk's and Court's review of said reports, it is

ORDERED:

- 1) That the guardian of the person and/or property in any guardianship within Bay County shall file the annual guardianship report within 90 days after the last day of the anniversary month the letters of guardianship were signed.
- 2) The Clerk's review of the guardianship report shall be forwarded to the Court contemporaneously with the Clerk's audit of the annual accounting in all cases.
- 3) In the event the Clerk shall identify an issue relating to the well-being of the ward in reviewing the annual report, the Clerk shall immediately forward the court file and the Clerk's review to the Court.
